Thanks to all those who have supported this step of faith. We have sought to fine tune this 'Fellowship' style of Worship in response to your suggestions and believe the format is starting to take shape.

We firmly believe that an integral part of 'Church' is Fellowship. We believe God's call is for us to be a community who share life together. This has been a trial of one way in which we can take the time, in God's presence, to discover what is happening in each other's lives. A time to pray for each other.
