<u>HOT TOPIC – 10.45am</u> SERVICE IN THE JD HALL.

When the decision was made to trial the second service in the JD Hall, I first thought "Why do we need to have the service in the hall when we have a church in which to hold the service?"

One good reason was the other Sunday, on entering the hall for the second service I noticed a stranger standing by themselves and another person who came in behind me noticed the same person by themselves. We both walked over to them, introduced ourselves, chatted for a while and then invited them to sit with us in our group for the service.

This person participated in the group's discussion etc and after the service stayed on for the soup and rolls lunch.

If this had been a service in the church we would not have noticed this person as we walked into the church. All one can see is the

back of people's heads on entering the church. This person would have probably not spoken to anyone (maybe a few at the passing of the peace) and left the service without chatting to anyone.

Sometimes it is hard to step out of our comfort zone to do something different. But if you think about it, if we refuse to give it a try, this is a selfish decision. Sometimes we need to do something different, step out of our comfort zone for the sake of others. It is disappointing to see our member's attendance drop off just because we are trailing something of which they are not in favour.

For this one small example I urge you if you haven't been to a second service in the hall to give it a try. It is a casual atmosphere with a very real feel of fellowship.
