# Response from Australian Lutherans to help refugees in southern Sudan Myanmar (Burma)

As you know, aid agencies have faced major challenges working in Myanmar (Burma) after Cyclone Nargis. The good news is our Australian Lutheran support that we are channeling through the proven ACT (Action by Churches Together) International network is successfully reaching the people who need it. Using this system and process (rather than ad hoc efforts) gives us the best means of ensuring aid is delivered efficiently and effectively, and provides sustainable help. Below is an excerpt from the latest update from on-the-ground teams.

Through already established networks of community-based organisations, members of ACT International have assisted more than 100,000 people. Volunteers are procuring relief goods locally in Yangon and in the Delta region. ACT members plan to provide safe water through the rehabilitation of 5,000 water points. Other planned assistance includes emergency shelter for up to 340,000 people, along with at least 10 days of food aid for up to 68,000 people. Members are also planning distribution of non-food items to 112,000 people.
