### LCA SAFE PLACE UPDATE

Sunday 22<sup>nd</sup> June at 1:15pm (Session 1) or 3pm (Session 2) in the JDHall.

**This update is for those who attended the LCA Safe Place Seminars in 2004 and 2005—every 3 years you are required to attend an update. If you have not previously attended a Safe Place Seminar there will be an opportunity in July to do so.**

Volunteers who work with vulnerable groups **need to attend** (this is a legal obligation that we as a church have to do)—i.e. Elders, Leadership & Admin Teams, those visiting on behalf of the congregation, babysitters, youth leaders, Sunday school teachers, sports coaches etc. You also need to have a **POLICE CHECK** prior to attending (need to have another every 3 years.)

If you have a police check which has been done in the last three years, please take it into the office and have it sighted by Jan. If not, forms are available from the office.

Please let Jan know at the church office which session you are attending on June 22<sup>nd</sup>.

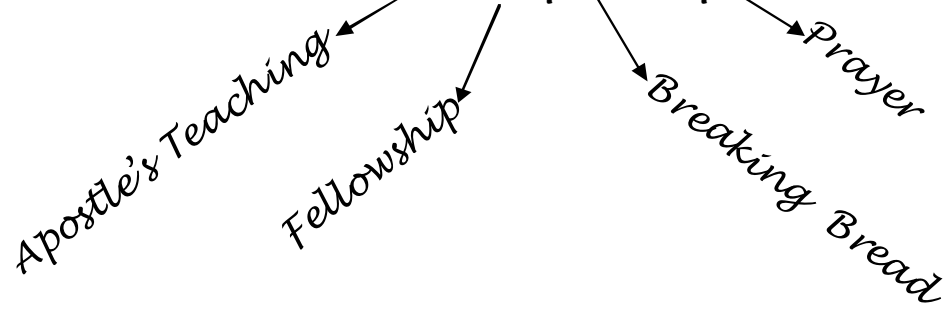

10.30am we start worship with people circulating and being called to worship with

**SCRIPTURE** - God’s Word being presented in various ways.

**OBSERVATION** – can take the form of discussion, workshop and the like with the Pastor; the focus on the theme of the day.

A short break at this point for hymns\songs and to make our offering

**APPLICATION** – this is a time to look at **YBH** (yes but how) can we put into practice what we have experienced, with the great commission ringing in our ears Matthew 28:18 – 20

**PRAYER** – a time to talk and listen to our Heavenly Father

Holy Communion is the very nearness to God within us and our commitment to continue our worship as a Church\Disciple, as we reclaim community awareness

We continue the worship service with a communal lunch, sharing what we have brought. People leaving in their own time

“If there is new thinking, then there will be new behaviour!”

It has been recommended that worship services could alternate between the JD Hall one Sunday and the worship centre the next Sunday.

That we trial this format for 2 months before reviewing the format.
