

Moses means; 'I drew him out of the water' where her father threw him. Has Jesus used unlikely people to help you?

Invite the Holy Spirit to send workers out into the harvest of souls in the world and around us. Pray for those you know going through difficult times. Pray for Jesus' view of life to replace a worldly perspective. Pray for the wisdom to know Jesus' will and the courage to do it no matter what. Pray for each other.
