

Matthew 11

Read through using three symbols:

? = question.

 $\heartsuit = \sin$ for when the light comes on.

 \rightarrow = arrow where Jesus is hitting the mark in your heart calling you to action.

Talking it Over

Focus on verses 16-30

Jesus asked; 'To what can I compare this generation?' How would you describe your generation: strengths—weaknesses.

No matter what John did, or Jesus did there was always something wrong. Where have you sought to celebrate a gift from Jesus and felt put down. Where have you felt a need for change and been ridiculed. How did it make you feel?

Reflect on verse 19.

What is Jesus trying to say to us through the list of towns that didn't repent? Where do you need to repent? Where might you be taking Jesus for granted. Do you ever believe things won't get any better, or similar thoughts? Time to repent. Share your thoughts.

'No one knows the Father except the Son.' What is significant about this verse? Elaborate.

When have you gone to Jesus for rest?

Praying

Invite the Holy Spirit to fill you with the peace that comes from Jesus. Pray about those areas you need rest. Invite Jesus to lead you to people that he might use you to lighten their burdens. Pray for those you know who are sick and their families. Ask the Spirit if he wants you to act in some way. Pray for each other by name.

Verse for the Week

Jesus says; "Come to me, all you who are weary and burdened, and I will give you rest." Matthew 11:28

Character Conversation Ouestions

Have I thanked Jesus this week? Do I look to money or Jesus to calm my fears and relieve my burdens? What do you find morally a burden?

What signs have I seen this week which call me to repentance?

How did I stand supporting his family with my time and effort?

Where have you had an opportunity to share about Jesus?

Where did you encounter Jesus this week? Did you finish your reading and hear from God? What are you going to do? Have you been honest with yourself?
