Matthew 13:1-24

Read through using three symbols:

? = question.

 $\heartsuit = \text{sun for when the light comes on.}$

 \rightarrow = arrow where Jesus is hitting the mark in your heart calling you to action.

Talking it Over

What are the various soil types? Where might they be represented in your life?

What makes for good soil? Elaborate on how you keep good soil in your life.

Jesus sees the seed as the 'message about the kingdom' verse 19. Put the message about the kingdom in your own words.

How are you cultivating the message of Jesus' kingdom in your life?

Does the soil make the seed grow, or does it only provide the right environment for the life in the seed to produce? Discuss. What might this mean for you?
