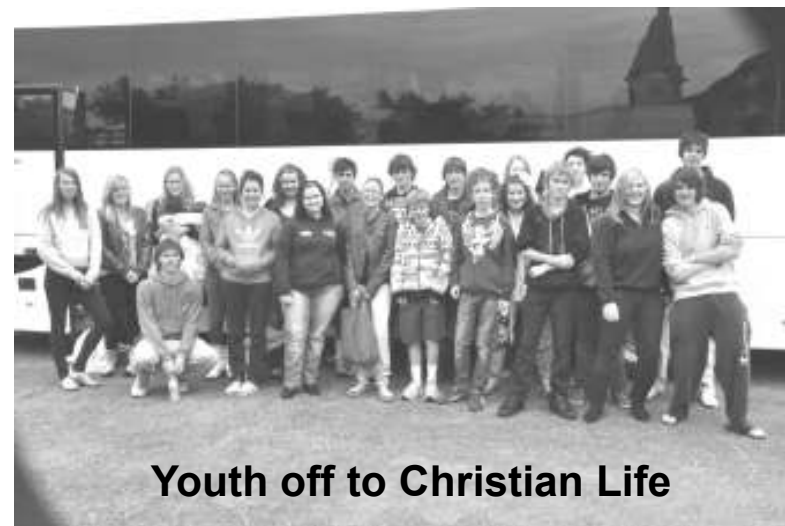

Talking it Over

What is God saying to you through the first
part of this chapter: 28:1-9

What do you think of when you hear of
Jacob's ladder?

Jacob saw a ladder stretching from heaven
to earth with angels ascending and
descending. What is God saying?

O.T. people believed that the place Jacob's
ladder touched the earth was where the
Holy of Holies stood in the Temple. In
relation to this what do you think Jesus
meant when he said he would destroy the
temple and rebuild it in three days?

Where does heaven and earth meet now?

In this encounter God makes a promise to
Jacob. Compare that with what Jacob says
in verses 20-22. Discuss.

What promises has God made to you?
Share how that shapes your life now.
How is your life the place heaven and earth
meet?

Praying

Invite the Holy Spirit to explain this story
to you. Pray that in your life people
encounter Jesus, that the kingdom of Jesus
touches them. Invite Jesus to lead you to
people that you might bring his kingdom to
them. Pray for those you know who are
sick and their families. Pray for each other
by name.
