



Talking it Over

What images come to your mind when you think of the Kingdom of Heaven.

What aspect of the Kingdom is shown in the parable about the mustard seed?

What's the emphasis in the story about the yeast?

Jesus uses the image of two people who once they find a fantastic treasure are willing to risk everything to get it. They sell all they have. How does this play out in your life? How do you sell everything for Jesus and his kingdom? What temptations do you face?

The last parable is that of the fish; good and bad. What is the impact of this parable on you.

For people to be 'thrown into the blazing furnace, where there will be weeping and gnashing of teeth' indicates to me that this is serious. Do I always live with this reality in mind? Discuss.

Holy Spirit show to us what a treasure we have in Jesus. Open our hearts and minds to where we are not giving our all for him. Holy Spirit use us where we live to by Jesus yeast and infect every area of life with his presence.
