

Talking it Over

Jacob means: He grasps the heel, a Hebrew idiom for he deceives. How is Jacob living up to his name at the start of the chapter.

What was Jacobs motivation? V7, 11.

v9-12 Jacob wrestles with God's call to go back. What do you think is going through his mind.

What clear promises has Jesus made? Do you ever wrestle and try and put your own twist on things? Discuss.

v24 Jacob is left alone—what is God symbolising here? How do you feel when left alone?

Jacob is attacked and wrestles till day break. What is God symbolising here? Have you ever had a long wrestle?

The man could easily have defeated Jacob. With one touch he dislocates his hip. What is God saving about wrestling with him?

What is significant about the name Israel?

Praying

Invite the Holy Spirit to open you up to Jesus' leading. Pray about those areas you feel tension, you are wrestling with. Invite Jesus to lead you to people that he might use you to lighten their burdens. Pray for those you know who are sick and their families. Ask the Spirit if he wants you to act in some way. Pray for each other by name.
