

The Federal Government has made a commitment at this stage to continue funding for another three years and to make some extra funding available so that schools who currently do not have a CPSW will be able to apply for funding.



Why did the Holy Spirit lead Jesus out into the wilderness?

Where do you feel tempted most?

Praying

Share with Jesus those areas of life where you are being tempted. Tempted to simply act on a felt need. Tempted to doubt him. Tempted to find security, life in other than Jesus.

Pray for each other; for the wisdom to see through the Devil's traps, for the love to support each other.

Enjoy being in Jesus' company.

Character Conversation Ouestions
