Ephesians 1 Read through using three symbols: ? = question. \Rightarrow = sun for when the light comes on. \Rightarrow = arrow where Jesus is hitting the mark in your heart calling you to action.

Talking it Over

What is special about 'Grace and Peace' from God our Father and the Jesus?

What is significant about v4-5 mentioning that we are chosen? What else are we in Jesus?

In verse16 Paul reminds the readers that he is giving thanks for their faith. How does it feel when people give you thanks? Who do you thank for the faith you have in Jesus?

Paul prays that his hearers might grow in wisdom and revelation so that they might know Jesus better. Discuss. What do you pray for people?

What else does Paul pray for his hearers? Discuss.

What is special about verse 20-23? How might this give us great confidence?

What is your first thought when you hear; 'Jesus is head over everything for the church, which is his body..."

Praying

Ask Jesus to fill you with his Spirit of wisdom and revelation. Ask Jesus to open the eyes of your heart to know the hope to which he has called you. Give thanks to God for those who brought you to faith and grew you in faith. Pray for each other.

Verse for the Week

"That power is the same as the mighty strength he exerted when he raised Christ from the dead..." Eph. 1:20ff

Character Conversation Questions

What's motivating you? Am I listening or telling Jesus. Have I taken regular time out. Have I loved my spouse, parents, family, friends? How have I loved people? What's driving my morality? How have I used God's gifts to me? Have I told the truth? Has the green monster of envy reared it's head this week? Am I doing Jesus will or my own? Where did I encounter Jesus this week? Did I finish my reading and hear from God? What am I going to do? Have I been honest with myself?
