Share your highs and lows for the week.

## Reading:

1 John 3:1-7

Read through using three symbols: Discuss

? = question.

☼ = sun for when the light comes on.

→ = arrow where Jesus is hitting the mark in your heart calling you to action.

## Talking it Over

How would you describe love from a worldly perspective and from Jesus' perspective? Discuss.

John writes: 'See what great love the Father has lavished on us, that we should be called children of God.' How does this make you feel? Do you enjoy having great love lavished on you? What does this say about how we might live?

'Sin is lawlessness' What do you believe John means? Is sin just having laws to follow, or is that something deeper? Discuss.

'No one who lives in him keeps on sinning' What does John mean? We're not perfect so what does he mean, especially in relation to being lawless? Discuss.

'Don't be lead astray... The one who does what is right is righteous.' What does John mean here? Surely he's not suggesting we're saved by what we do, then the cross wouldn't be needed.

How has God loved you today?
