

Privacy Statement

Christ Church Lutheran, Murray Bridge, as are all Congregations, are bound and governed by the Privacy (Private Sector) Act 2000.

We also come under the various compliances in regard to Safe Place, Child Safe and all members involved in caring and visiting also require a Police Check for such clearance to be involved.

Further, in order to comply with the privacy of members when video and photos are shown, written permission is required.

It is planned to have an updated Members and Friends Directory available early next year to members. This directory will be similar to that printed in 2009 showing Family names and addresses, phone and mobile numbers and also email addresses.

As it is not practical to obtain permission in writing from all our members listed in the Directory at this stage, we ask that you read the Privacy Statement that was adopted by the Administration Team on 17th December 2012.

It reads as follows:

Christ Church Lutheran, Murray Bridge is bound and governed by the Privacy (Private Sector) Act 2000 and the 10 National Privacy Principles that form part of the Act.

We collect this information about you before, during and after your membership with us. We do this for efficiency in making contact with you, to offer spiritual guidance and support when requested. This information is kept in secure Data Storage and can only be accessed by persons involved in Ministry of the

Church.

You do not have to give this information to us, but, not doing so may compromise our ability to care for you.

We may include your Name and, where applicable, contact details on membership lists, prayer lists, bulletins, newsletters, rosters, Directory and similar Church publications.

I understand that this information will not be forwarded to other organisations without my consent, and will be only used for pastoral care and programmes within the Lutheran Church of Australia. I give my consent that <u>contact</u> details (minus details marked 'Private') may be published in the Congregation Directory and other church publications. I also understand that unless indicated above, my image may be used for promotional purposes, in print and electronic media by the local church.

In the latter part of January 2013, you will be able to ask to view your personal information that is already on file, and ask for it to be corrected or up-dated if need be or if some details are to remain private.
