Dear members of the LCA SA/NT District,

I want to thank you on behalf of the District Church Council for your partnership with your wider church family in supporting the work we do together as Synod. While we still ended up with a deficit of \$66,000 at the end of 2011, your gifts through offerings were again up on the previous year and we thank God for your generosity in sharing 1.57 million in offerings with your District for the work we do together. In addition I know you are generous in all sorts of other ways including the gift of \$1.8 million from our District to Australian Lutheran World Service as one example.

We realise that some congregations are struggling to meet local commitments and several do not know how they will survive, so we are grateful for the contributions we have received and encourage all congregations to join us in what we do together in the mission of our Lord. It may interest you to know that the trend is for smaller congregations to increase their giving to the wider church and for larger ones to be decreasing their District /LCA support.

The challenge is not getting smaller, and I need to make you aware that this year we are behind on where we need to be to meet fund the work we do together as Synod and we are looking at a deficit of \$81,000 at the end of 2012. Please prayerfully consider that need which we share in together as you plan your giving for the remainder of the year. I hope you will see that not as a burden but a joy.

Resourcing the work of your church financially is a challenge we face together and Synod delegates will be asked to consider how we might go about funding the ministry of the District in the future. We simply cannot budget for large deficits indefinitely.

Identifying and challenging people to consider becoming pastors is something I would also ask you to prayerfully consider during the month of July. As you know we have many vacancies in our District and with another six retirements due before the end of the year this need will become more obvious. Can I ask you as congregations to pray to the Lord of the harvest during the month of July to raise up workers - pastors, teachers and lay-workers to serve him in these ways. I urge your Pastoral assistants / elders to meet with your pastors and identify people in your congregations that you might wish to prayerfully place the challenge before. Do that humbly and respectfully and without pressure, but do let people know if you see them as potentially serving God in this way.

I look forward to seeing your delegates at Synod. I understand this is a costly exercise but we believe it will not only be an affirmation, encouragement and a blessing to our brothers and sisters in the Northern Territory, but also an enriching and broadening experience for the pastors and delegates, many of whom have never ventured to this special place in the history of the LCA.

May the Lord continue to bless our life together and use us to bless our communities with the Good News and love of Christ.
