Share your highs and lows for the week.

Reading:

Ruth 1

Read through using three symbols: Discuss
? = question.

☼ = sun for when the light comes on.

→ = arrow where Jesus is hitting the mark
in your heart calling you to action.

IMPORTANT:
Do this first, letting God speak.

Talking it Over

What was the first thought to come to your mind? Share it. What do you think it might mean?

Why did Naomi leave Israel? What is significant about that reason? Discuss.

How do you think Naomi was feeling at the death of her husband and then her two sons living in a foreign land? How do you think you would have felt?

What do you see as the difference between Ruth and Orpah?

What is significant about Naomi's family tree? Where does she come from? Who comes from her family line in the future? What thoughts come to your mind as you reflect on this?

Ruth refuses to leave Naomi even though she could. What causes people to quit on each other? What could we learn from Ruth?

Who are the people who have stuck by you through thick and thin?

Praying

Ask Jesus who he wants you to see this week. Ask to be filled with the Holy Spirit so you don't give up but let Jesus' love win the day. Pray personally for each other. Where are you tempted to quit?

Character Conversation Questions

What word of encouragement do I have to share and with who?

What have I learned this week? Who can I share it with?
