Grace a family with water for life

clean and safe

Each day, nearly 10,000 people die from diseases caused by dirty water. Most are children under five years old. You can protect a family in a country like Cambodia with a simple household water filter. Water is poured in the top and filters through clay to remove impurities. Children can then be safe.

bore - but not boring

Girls in South Sudan (often starting as young as 5) are responsible for collecting water each day. They must walk many kilometres, and it is dangerous and exhausting work. Often it means the girls are too tired to cope with school. They fail, can't get a job, and remain trapped in poverty. Our Lutheran team plans to urgently repair 20 boreholes in South Sudan. Each can provide up to 1000 people with clean water, and we'd expect the repaired borehole to have a lifespan of 20 years. Your Gift of Grace can repair one of these 20 bore-holes.

In South Sudan, children may only have dirty water to drink. It is disease-ridden and can carry guinea worm larvae. A drinking straw is a filter built into a tube. Children carry it on a string around their neck so they can always have clean water. The straw removes 99.9999% of waterborne bacteria, 99.9% of waterborne protozoan parasites, and particles down to 0.2 microns.
