



WHAT DOES A CHRISTIAN PASTORAL SUPPORT WORKER DO?

A Christian Pastoral Support Worker is a Christian, with special skills for working with young people and their families in the school community.

A SCHOOL CHRISTIAN PASTORAL SUPPORT WORKER WILL:

- work in co-operation with teachers and the Principal to support students;
- be available to students as a listener, supporter and carer;
- be a support, resource and referral person for families in the school community;
- be a support, resource and referral person for teachers and other staff;
- work with others in the school and its community to develop services, programs, and strategies, that meet the needs of students;
- provide a Christian presence in the school on behalf of the local churches.
- being visible in the school yard, when they accompany teachers on yard duty;
- · being available at lunch times;

- working alongside teachers and students in the classrooms;
- being at school during "special occasions" eg Presentation
 Night

HOW CAN I HELP?

- Join our team of regular supporters and donate monthly, quarterly, yearly.
- Fund a CPSW for an extra hour of work per week - \$23 per week for 40 weeks.
- Organise a fundraising event
- Support the Task Group fundraising events
- Bake for a staff support morning tea
- Assist in putting on a staff support morning tea, meet and talk with staff
- Assist a CPSW with lunchtime activities.
- Be a prayer contact for a CPSW and pray for specific needs in that school

A few facts about Christian Pastoral Support Workers in SA schools

In a government school, the Christian Pastoral Support Program is primarily a service of pastoral care for students and their families, as well as staff, who want this support. Christian Pastoral Support Workers are not in the school to evangelise on behalf of a particular faith group. Their role requires them to respect both the secular character of the Government School and the variety of thoughts and beliefs within the school community.

As a Christian presence in the school, the Christian Pastoral Support Worker represents and encourages key Christian values, and celebrates the diversity of Christianity.

The School Christian Pastoral Support Worker is jointly accountable to the Department of Education and Children's Services through the School Principal, SMG and the Murray Bridge Inter-church Council.

Who Employs our Christian Pastoral Support Worker?

Our CPSWs are employed for 15 hours per week by SMG through the Federal government's National School Chaplaincy and Student Welfare Progam. Additional hours per week can be funded by the local Interchurch Council. The local community is also responsible for the provision and payment of Christian options seminars in the schools.



Who is SMG? Schools Ministry Group

The Schools Ministry Group was set up by the Heads of Churches to employ Christian workers in Government Schools (CPSW's).

The Group consists of representatives from all the major Christian Churches and several youth and children's mission organizations.

SMG is responsible for developing policy, giving pastoral and resource support to over 340 Christian Pastoral Support Workers, liaising with schools and churches about the **Christian Pastoral Support Program** and organizing 'In Service' training for Christian Pastoral Support Workers in South Australia.

Role of Murray Bridge Interchurch Council

The Murray Bridge Interchurch Council has appointed a subcommittee – The Ministry in Schools Task Group. The Task Group liaises with the schools, local churches and SMG to appoint and review Christian Pastoral Support Workers. The group is responsible for the pastoral oversight and support of the CPSWs, fundraising to support extra hours and provision of seminars and programs and assisting to raise the profile of the CPSW program in the local churches.

Who are our Christian Pastoral Support Workers?

Murray Bridge has 2 Federally Funded workers:-

Lisa Riley – Murray Bridge High School Narelle Chester – Murray Bridge North Schools.

Lisa and Narelle both work 15 hours per week and from Term 2 2012, Lisa will be funded by the Task Group for an extra 3 hours per week.

Desma Blake is funded by the Task Group, for 3 hours per week at Fraser Park. Desma also volunteers a further 9 hours per week at the school.

The Task Group has also provided some financial support to assist Carelle Poole who is the CPSW at Coomandook.

Federal Funding is guaranteed until 2015 but after that it is unknown whether Federal Funding will be available or not. The Christian Pastoral Support Program is an initiative of the Christian Churches and we need to continue our ownership of the program. We need your help to continue to provide a Christian presence and support in our Government schools.
