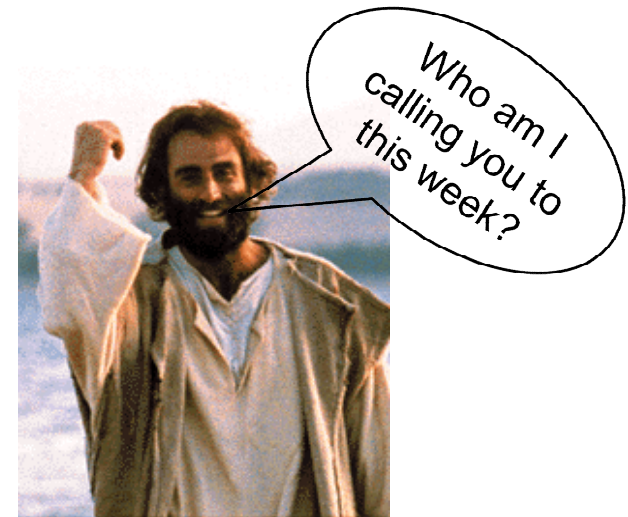

importance of each one. If this is who we
are, what impact would that have on the
way we live? Discuss.

What is the big difference between the
pagans and the Christians? If it's not what
we do then what is it?

essential. Ask Jesus who he wants you to
see this week. Ask for the wisdom, love
and courage to offer to pray for people in
their felt needs this week. Ask to be filled
with the Holy Spirit so you can go in his
strength, always doing what Jesus does.
