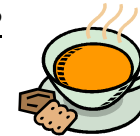

**(mostly as recorded by our Lutheran Missionaries).**

At level 1 of the (excellently signposted) Barr Smith Library at the University of Adelaide. Throughout July, Clara Stockigt, has prepared an exhibition on the documentation of Kaurna/Adelaide (Teichelmann and Schurmann, the 1st Lutheran Pastors in SA), Ngarrindjeri/Encounter Bay, (Meyer), Parnkalla/Pt Lincoln, Dieri/Lake Killalpaninna and Aranda languages. These illustrate an unsurpassed, dedicated intellectual collaboration between Indigenous Australians and Europeans starting 175 years ago.

150 years ago, next March, the two synods resolved to initiate our own Mission.
