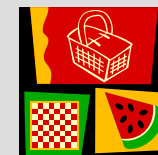

Hello Friends of CLW!

We hope that you have had a wonderful Christmas celebrating Jesus' birth, and a great start to 2012.

As we begin this new year, and prepare to head off to camp in a few hours, we thought we would have a look back at the year that's been for LMSE CLW, and also look forward to what 2012 may hold in store for the youth of the LMSE zone, and thus all who live in the area and interact with these young people.

2011 saw a number of changes for CLW - a great camp in July at Adare in Victor Harbor, with a significant percentage of new campers joining us. God also gave the vision of CLW 360, the outcome of years of gentle nudging and preparing; we launched our new ministry and have had several catch up services and our first teaching session. The teaching session, on Spiritual Gifts, was led by our 2011 camp speaker, Rob Berlin. Rob's words were once again very well received by all who attended.

The end of 2011 also saw Alex Bishop and Liam Hensel stepping down from their director roles. Both have been on the co-ordinating team for the past 5 years, and directing for various time periods within that. They have blessed the camp richly with their passion, their heart, and their skills. May God continue to bless them and use them to bless others as they follow Christ to where He leads them next in life. They will both be sadly missed, but we also are excited to see who God is calling to step up and take on more responsibility within the CLW ministries. A number of experienced, well loved leaders have also decided that it is time for them to move on from CLW - once again, we will feel this loss, but wish them all the best for what's in store next for them, and hope to still see them at some of our 360 events.

Kristian Le Gallou has stepped from his co-ordinator and first time leader position to join Bethany as director over the LMSE CLW ministries. We are excited to see where he will take the camp, from the already strong foundation that has been built, particularly over the past half decade or so.

Coming up this Saturday we have another 360 event, *Christian Life Weekend!* This camp is designed as a (CLW) family camp, aimed at the young people who have attended CLW, to join together for a relaxed weekend away. Whilst we didn't advertise the camp heavily outside of previous camp attendees, we are excited to have a few new faces in attendance. The camp is being held down at the Tarooki campsite, Robe. 3 days/2 nights of immersing ourselves in God's presence, taking a step back from the busyness of 'reality', building deeper relationships with each other, and spending time in reflection and prayer as we dedicate 2012 to God - both as a CLW community and as individuals. The camp theme is "here fishy, fishy", and is based around John 21. If you would like to see a bit more about where we are headed with this, please download the attached devotionals that comprise the booklet; written by our team of dedicated leaders, they walk through John 21, highlighting different aspects of the text.

We ask you to join us for this camp - by uplifting it in prayer. Please pray as God leads you; but for some direction of what we feel we need:

- For the 25 campers and 10 small group leaders to come with open hearts and minds to receive from God. To be open and vulnerable; for the Holy Spirit to come into the depths of their hearts, and to be inspired, strengthened and refreshed to live their lives wholly for Christ always. We also pray especially for the 2 new campers joining us.
- For the camp to be free from illness and injury.
- For safe travel; we have a number of campers driving down - for them to be safe on the roads. And also for all who are driving home on Monday to be rested and refreshed.
- For the weather; with a forecast of only 24, 20, 20, and rain likely, this is not quite conducive for beach swimming and outdoor games! May it be warm enough to swim comfortably, and may the rain not interfere with activities
- For our band; a new band, who haven't had the opportunity to all meet together and practice as a full band. To play skilfully, to worship fully, and to be guided by the Holy Spirit, as they lead the camp in worship over the weekend.
- For the activities; that all are prepared. That those running them are organised and free from worry. That the activities taking place in small groups and amongst the town are safe. As we enjoy the wonderful creation of God, including the sea, that once again, we are all safe.

- For the small groups and the devotional booklet; may relationships be built. May the leaders have knowledge and wisdom. May people be open and willing to share themselves; may they also be ready to accept others for where they are at, and deal with one another in love. May friendships be strengthened.
- For the co-ordinating team: Emma who is both a camper and our worship co-ordinator. For Holly, as our leader co-ordinator; And for Ella, as the admin co-ordinator.
- For Kristian and Bethany, as camp directors, to have wisdom, courage, strength, and unity. Particularly for Kristian, as his first camp fully in the director role. To follow God's promptings. To follow the Spirit, wherever He leads. To know when they need rest, and to have energy to run the camp. To be positive, Christ-like role models for the campers and other leaders. To also ensure they take time to be alone with God.
- For the cooks, for Pr Wayne and Correen, for the Berlin family as they visit; for the managers of the campsite, and for all in town who we interact with - may we be the light of God to them; even if they see us only from a distance, may they notice that there is something different about us... and that that difference is Christ.

Looking forwards to the rest of 2012; we have a number of 360 events to come, before "The Week" in September. With 4 more teaching sessions, spread out around the zone, and catch up services, we look forward to continually connecting with not only the youth, but also with the congregations in the zone. Stay tuned for more information on these events - and please keep them in your prayers, as we look for venues, speakers, and organisers for each event. We also hope to see some of you in attendance!

The full week long CLW camp will be held from September 24-28, at Pendleton Farm Stay, Keith. Once again, there shall be much more to come on this in the months ahead.
