





Find a map of the world or a world globe. In your home devotional times this week, share what you know about different parts of the world. Each day pray for the people in a different part of the world, that they would know God's love for them and come to know and follow Jesus as their Saviour.

Wilderness box

When speaking to Nicodemus, Jesus said that he would be "lifted up" just as "Moses lifted up the snake in the desert" (John 3:14; see Numbers 21:4-9). For this week's symbol, place a stick into your wilderness box. Wrap a pipe cleaner around the stick to represent the bronze snake.

Sav this praver together: Heavenly Father, your Son Jesus was lifted up on a cross to save us from the sickness of sin. Thank you for your great love for the whole world! Amen.

VIOLET (Or PURPLE) is the color of royalty, repentance, and self-discipline. VIOLET (or Purple) is the traditional color for the season of Lent. This deep rich color somberness, penitence, and prayer. It is a time when we re-orientate our lives towards God, both as individuals and as a community, we look inward and reflect on our readiness to follow Jesus in his journey towards the cross.
