

This week we remember the journey of Jesus from his entry in Jerusalem to his last meal, trial, crucifixion, death, and resurrection. These stories are central to our faith.

Let the structure of Holy Week guide your home activities. It's especially helpful to plan for Friday and Saturday to be quiet, at-home days, with few scheduled activities.

Plan simple meals and cut back on treats and use of media. Agree on times when you can gather together to reflect on the events of Jesus' passion.

This deep rich color somberness, penitence, and prayer.
