NATIONAL WEEKEND OF PRAYER FOR SCHOOL CHAPLAINCY

Friday 9th February to Sunday 11th February

On Tuesday 8 May 2018 the Federal Government will announce whether it will uphold the current funding provided for the National School Chaplaincy Programme (NSCP).

Currently the NSCP funds more than 3000 school chaplains in Australia (called 'Pastoral Care Workers' in SA), who play a vital role in school and local communities, providing invaluable social, emotional and spiritual support to children, young people and their families.

I urge you to join hundreds of thousands of Christians across Australia by including a short time of prayer in each of your services that weekend (9-11 Feb), for the continuation of funding for school chaplaincy in Australia.

We're asking all churches, religious organisations and communities of faith to pull together to ensure the lifeline of chaplaincy is always available for our children in Australian schools and the best place to start is on our knees!



Creative Response



For many centuries the fish has been an important Christian symbol. In the time of the early church, it was dangerous to be known as a Christian in some parts of the Roman Empire; so believers developed a "code language" to reveal their faith to other Christians. A Christian would draw on the ground the upper half of a fish symbol. If the other person was a Christian they would recognise this and add a second curved line to complete the drawing of a fish.

- Make a list of names (perhaps in the shape of a fish!) of people you know who do not know Jesus. Pray for them.
- Go on a "chalk walk" in your local community. Use chalk to draw the fish symbol on footpaths in your neighbourhood. When you do so, pray for the people who work or live nearby, that they may live with faith in Jesus.
- Come up with your own household "code language" to symbolise your faith in Jesus.

Creative Response



For many centuries the fish has been an important Christian symbol. In the time of the early church, it was dangerous to be known as a Christian in some parts of the Roman Empire; so believers developed a "code language" to reveal their faith to other Christians. A Christian would draw on the ground the upper half of a fish symbol. If the other person was a Christian they would recognise this and add a second curved line to complete the drawing of a fish.

- Make a list of names (perhaps in the shape of a fish!) of people you know who do not know Jesus. Pray for them.
- Go on a "chalk walk" in your local community. Use chalk to draw the fish symbol on footpaths in your neighbourhood. When you do so, pray for the people who work or live nearby, that they may live with faith in Jesus.
- Come up with your own household "code language" to symbolise your faith in Jesus.
