

Murray Bridge Fire Community Fund



making pretzels is a Lenten tradition.

Pretzels are shaped like arms folded in prayer, and can remind us to pray to God for our needs and the needs of others. Use the following recipe to make pretzels (the recipe lists the amount of ingredients per person):

Have each person sprinkle ½ teaspoon of veast into 3 tablespoons of warm water. Stir to dissolve. Add ½ teaspoon of sugar, ½ cup of flour and 2 tablespoons of grated cheese. Stir, then knead until smooth. Cut the dough into 4 pieces and roll into a snake shape. Shape the 4 pieces like pretzels, then brush them with a beaten egg. Sprinkle with coarse ground salt. Bake on a baking sheet at 220 degrees Celsius for 15 minutes.
