

Please refer to the LCA Nominations page: <u>www.lca.org.au/nominations</u> for further information about the nominations process and to download the nominations form. Please note the following:

- Although individuals can self-nominate, nominations, with the consent of the nominee, may also be submitted by congregations to the LCA Standing Committee on Nominations.
- 2. As resolved at the 2015 General Convention of Synod no nominations can be moved from the floor. It is therefore essential that if your congregation wants to nominate someone, the nomination form must be submitted to the LCA Standing Committee on Nominations by the closing date of 15 May 2018.




