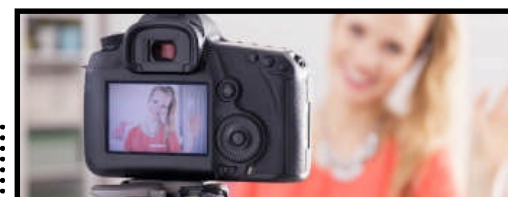

Read Psalm 1.
