Part 3. Deep & Wide Book Review – (see prev. bulletins for earlier parts)

In the midst of the explosive, unexplainable growth and expansion of the early church, the *ekklesia* of Jesus would find itself wrestling with a question we continue to wrestle with today. Namely, who is the *ekklesia* for? Who gets to participate? What are the requirements for membership? How good do people have to be? How good must they continue to be once they're in?

Is the church for church people? If so, what exactly does that mean?

Andy grew up attending churches designed for church people. No one said it, but the assumption was that church was for church people. The unspoken message to the outside world was, "once you start believing and behaving like us, you are welcome to join us."

Churches are for broken, sinful people. Period.

Andy Says, "Surely among the most controversial questions I've encountered in my time in ministry is "Who is the church for? Christians or non-Christians." The answer seems obvious to me: both! The church is made up of Christians and, thus, exists to build them up. But the church, made up of Christians, also exists to reach those who are far from God."




