



This week we will look at the 2nd & 3rd disciplines of the 5 catalysts in growing faith that Andy has identified.

Catalyst # 2 Private Disciplines

When God speaks to us personally through his Word or answers prayer, our faith is strengthened. Jesus put a huge emphasis on our secret times with him in prayer. If that is going to be the norm for everyone instead of the exception, it needs to get weaved it into the fabric of everything that is done.

From the very beginning Andy has looked for ways to motivate and equip people to engage in some kind of devotional exercise. One of their most important ministries is Starting Point, which introduces seekers and returners to the importance of self-study and prayer. They also encourage people to grow in giving. Parents are given a Parent Card every month, which is a simple way to help parents lead their children in a daily devotion. They also believe that the sooner they can get unbelievers reading their Bible, the better. They also will sometimes print out prayers for people to pray.
