- ➡ How do we answer the question "who is my neighbour?" as members at Christ Church Lutheran. The people who live next to us? Our work mates?, People we come in contact with either on a daily basis or by opportunity? Our greater community?
- ▶ Being the best neighbours means congregations reflect mercy toward the people outside their walls by using the example set by Jesus in Matthew 22:34-40 (loving God with all our heart, loving our neighbour as ourselves) and Luke 10:25-37 (the good Samaritan).
- Churches that grow young, neighbour well by honouring what's good, making their world better, and respecting the journey as much as the destination. These congregations show love to a neighbour that is greater than differences in ethnic background, culture and socioeconomic status.

Read the parable of the Good Samaritan in Luke 10:25-37, listening prayerfully to Jesus' story-based definition of who our neighbours are, what it means to love them, and how this is an extension of loving God.






