LCA—Guidelines on Hygiene in Worship (with reference to possible infection from Coronavirus COVID-19)

Gathering as a worship community

At present, there is no need to cancel regular worship services.

If the situation deteriorates and mass gatherings are being discouraged by government authorities, congregations will need to make provisions for the spiritual support of their members.

Congregations may wish to consider online worship alternatives, such as having the pastor write and/or record a sermon to place on the church website, directing people to livestreamed services/Worship DVDs.

Good Hygiene Practices in Churches


It is recommended that handshaking and hugging at church be discouraged during the outbreak to minimise the possibility of infection. People should be reassured that it is alright to refuse this kind of contact, and that a smile and nod and a friendly greeting are sufficient.

LCA—Guidelines for the Distribution of Holy Communion (with reference to possible infection from Coronavirus COVID-19)

• Research indicates that good communion hygiene is the best protector against infection.

It is recommended that:

- Pastors, communion attendants and any people preparing the elements exercise excellent hand hygiene, .
- Any pastor or communion attendant displaying symptoms of respiratory illness should not be involved in preparation or distribution.
- Prior to distribution, an announcement should be made explicitly asking that people with any kind of respiratory illness (coughing, sneezing etc) or open wounds on their lips or tongues (eg herpes), should refrain from using the common cup.
- During distribution, the communion cup should be wiped both inside and outside the rim between each communicant, and the communion cup should be rotated a quarter turn after wiping.
- Whilst there is a limited risk of infection from the common cup, excellent hygiene must be followed and those who are unwell encouraged not to drink from the common cup.
- It is recommended that intinction be discontinued during times of public health emergencies.
- **Receiving under One Kind:** That is, consuming only the wine or only the bread. The pastor should state that ideally both bread and wine should be consumed, emphasising that this change is temporary and intended for the protection of the people.
