Creative Response

Gather four small pots or containers.

Lord God, please keep us from having hearts that are hard, like a path.
Keep us from having hearts that are shallow, like soil on rocky ground.
Keep us from having hearts that are easily choked, like seeds among thorns.
Instead, make our hearts like good soil, so that we gladly receive your word and accept it. Amen.
