Creative Response

Gather four small pots or containers.

Fill the first with gravel to represent a path, the second with rocks, the third with thorns or thistles, and the fourth with good soil.

Place these in your home devotional area. As part of your household devotional times this week, say the following prayer:

Lord God, please keep us from having hearts that are hard, like a path. Keep us from having hearts that are shallow, like soil on rocky ground. Keep us from having hearts that are easily choked, like seeds among thorns. Instead, make our hearts like good soil, so that we gladly receive your word and accept it. Amen.

From soil and seed you give us food to chew. Show us the work you want us to do. Amen. verse for the week

The seeds that fell on good ground are the people who hear and understand the message. They produce as much as a hundred or sixty or thirty times what was planted. MATTHEW 13:23
