

Motion 1: To change 8.1 An Annual General Meeting of the Congregation shall normally be held in February or March, but must be held within five (5) months after the expiration of the Financial Year, to transact the following business

To read as: 8.1 An Annual General Meeting of the Congregation shall normally be held in February or March, but must be held within three (3) months after the expiration of the Financial Year, to transact the following business

This is to place us in line with the current Incorporation requirements

Motion 2: To change 8.1.3 to receive the audited financial statements of the Congregation for the previous year;

To read as: 8.1.3 to receive the audited or checked financial statements of the Congregation for the previous year, in line with current government legislation Government regulations change as to the requirements for auditing or checking – currently if revenue is over \$500,000 an audit is required, otherwise just a review. This amount has changed over the years, referring to the legislation will cover future changes

Motion 3: To change 9.7 The Congregation shall elect an auditor annually, in accordance with the Act, who shall examine thoroughly the financial records of the Treasurer and vouch for their correctness or otherwise and advise in writing, on aspects of the Congregations finances.

To read as: 9.7 The Congregation shall elect an auditor or financial checker annually, in accordance with the Act, who shall examine thoroughly the financial records of the Treasurer and vouch for their correctness or otherwise and advise in writing, on aspects of the Congregations finances.

This allows for either auditing or reviewing of the financial records
