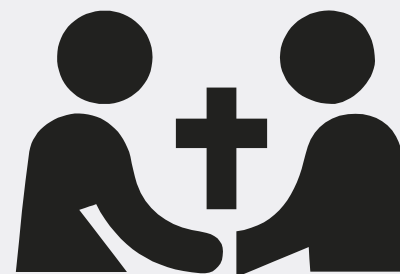
Sundays after Pentecost
