



Myanmar News – Pastor August Fricke update on Health Recent news from Yangon, Myanmar. The country is in the grip of a severe second wave of Covid-19. Schools have closed and people are confined to their homes and where they live, except to get food, medical treatment and to conduct essential business, eg. financial. Pastor Martin cannot go out to Damadi Home. The children and staff are keeping well and thank us for raising funds for Damadi via the Music Concert. We have contact with Pastor Sanglura via Messenger. Pastor August Fricke is in hospital in Brisbane receiving treatment for a brain tumour. He is in good spirits and thanks everyone for their prayers and support. August is hopeful of being allowed to return home to Gympie late this week Friday or early on Monday 19th October. He is in no real pain and the cancer treatment will continue on a regular basis via oncology appointments. Please continue to pray for Pastor August, CEO of Asia Focus Australia. 

An important faith practice is regular giving to the Lord through Sunday offerings.

Include each household member in the practice of giving (even very young children can be involved).
