### Wilderness Box

The season of Lent begins with Jesus in the wilderness and journeys toward the cross and the tomb.

Make up a "wilderness box" as a Lenten feature for your meal table or home devotional area. Line the inside of a shoebox with plastic. Fill most of the box with soil and then put a layer of sand over the top. For each week of Lent you will be able to add a different symbol to the box.
