It operates in men's and women's correctional centres around Australia, and is based on a 3 to 5 day 'Short Course' run inside the centre by a team of highly trained volunteers. The inmates who take part in **Kairos** can choose whether they want to attend or not. The program is completely voluntary.

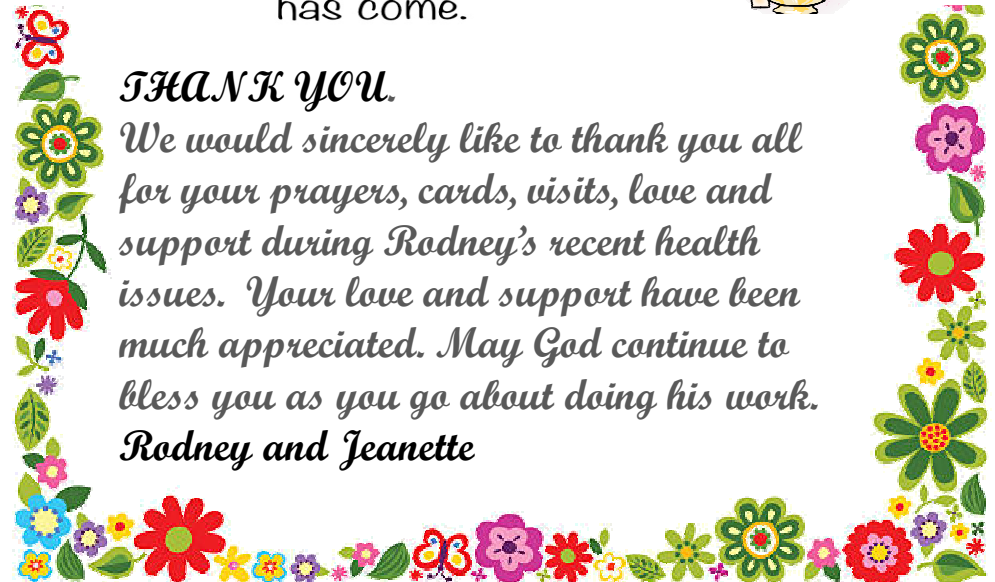

HOW YOU CAN SUPPORT THE KAIROS PRISON MINISTRY

Kairos is a ministry of passing on God's love to prison inmates and officials. You are invited to be part of this ministry by sharing in any of the following:

1. PRAYER

Prayer is the foundation of the whole Kairos ministry. Your prayers leading up to and during the program are greatly appreciated.

Please pray for:

- God to prepare the inmates who will be invited to the program,
- The team leaders and preparations of their teams,
- The receptiveness of the inmates (our guests) who participate in the program,
- The smooth running of the program, and for the success of fundraising.

An **80-hour** International prayer vigil covers the duration of the program. The prayer vigil is divided into 1/2hour timeslots and extends from 12.00pm on Tuesday 22nd June to 8:00pm on Friday 25th June 2021.

We need 160 people who are willing to pray for 30 minute time slots (wherever you are) during the program.

The Team members and the men from Mobilong are amazed and incredibly encouraged to know that there are people literally all over the world praying for them and this Kairos course.

2. POSTERS and PLACEMATS

These put a name and face to the Body of Christ. Either individually, in a Sunday School class or other group, you are encouraged to make a poster which will be displayed during the Kairos program.

Posters should convey greetings from the maker(s) to **"The men of Kairos Mobilong #29"** (or similar), and express the love and hope found in Christ, or a short Bible verse.

Children could also be asked to make colourful **placemats**, for example on A4 paper / coloured card which will be used during meal times. Please use only your own pictures and words. **Nothing is to be pasted onto the sheet including glitter and stickers.** The Agape team will laminate these as they are received. If prepared by people under 18 years old, no identification of the person or their age is permitted on posters or placemats.

3. FINANCIAL SUPPORT

Another way to respond to Jesus' calling *to care for prisoners* is by providing the financial resources for the Kairos program. Each Kairos program currently costs around \$4500.

Donations are tax-deductible, sent directly by **Direct Debit**: BSB: 035-045 A/C No. 157255, or and can be handed to a Kairos representative, or by **cheque** to: Kairos Prison Ministry Australia c/- PO Box 242 Highgate South Aust 5063. A receipt will be forwarded to you.

4. LETTERS

During the Kairos program, each guest will be given a bundle of short and encouraging letters. These may be sourced from people over 16 years old, including friends or partners of team members, and from Church congregations.

These letters often have a profound impact on the recipients, many of whom have been rejected by both society and their families. 240 letters are required.

Letters should be addressed “**Dear friend**” and should express the assurance of God’s love for the person, and of the writer’s prayers for them. It can be helpful to write about the forgiving nature of God, and to include personal examples of receiving forgiveness.

- **Letters must be hand-written and each one unique**, as the men on the course will be opening these letters while they are all together, and potentially showing theirs to others.
- Often people will write a letter based on a daily bible verse or meditation.
- Attractive printed note paper or a printed card may be used **but please do not use any form of scrapbook or glue or stick anything onto your letters.**
- The letters or cards are to be placed unfolded in a plastic sleeve, with a suitable envelope, but not inside the envelope. **Please do not put your address on letters or envelopes.**
- Please indicate the number of letters you have contributed on the sheet provided by your Kairos representative.

5. BISCUITS AND SLICES

Here is the opportunity for you to make tangible, visible (and edible) expressions of the love of your Christian community for the guests and team members on this Short Course.

As these expressions of love will be going inside Mobilong, the following guidelines apply:

- Freshly handmade biscuits or slices, both savoury and sweet, and not shop bought.
- Slices requiring no refrigeration.
- A variety of biscuits. Decorated biscuits are particularly sought after – all **edible** decorations may be used
- **Dried fruits** may be used
- Biscuits may be iced, but **must not be sprinkled with, or rolled in icing sugar** .
- **NO NUTS in or decorating any biscuits or slices due to possible allergies of guest or team members. Vegemite may not be used as an ingredient.**
- Historically we have received a lot of ANZAC & Chocolate Chip biscuits so other varieties would be fantastic. If you have a favourite recipe why not send it along too for others to add to our list.

After you have made YOUR favourites, and if you are at a loss, we have available some recipes on a separate sheet. Don’t forget that Savoury Biscuits are very welcome and often a good alternative for later in the afternoon.

UP TO 750 DOZEN BISCUITS/SLICES ARE USED THROUGHOUT THE SHORT COURSE!

- They are on tables for snacks each day during talks and discussions for guests and team members.
- Each Guest on the course receives a bag of biscuits each evening.
- There are special plates of decorated biscuits distributed during the Forgiveness Service.
- They are distributed around the whole prison to staff and all prisoners on the last day.
- As a Thank You platter to our Base, Church of Christ at Murray Bridge
- Each day they are given to the prison staff on the front desk and those on duty in the centre.

Please pack biscuits & slices **in ice-cream containers. Please pop in the container snap-lock bags suitable for one dozen biscuits.** Mark on the lid the number of pieces (eg 2doz) & variety (eg Decorated Shortbread). **Please make sure your Kairos representative has your biscuits/slices by Saturday June 19th, 2021.** The closer to the biscuits are made to Saturday June 19th the fresher they will be for our course. Murray Bridge-Monarto Shared Ministry Proposal

Recommendations

The following recommendations need to be presented at duly constituted meetings of the three congregations for endorsement.

It is recommended that:

We engage in a shared ministry-mission venture across the Murray Bridge-Monarto region between Christ Church, Murray Bridge, Holy Cross, Murray Bridge and Zion, Monarto. The shared venture will involve:

- Sharing two pastor positions across the congregations, comprising of a 1.0FTE Lead Pastor position and a **0.6FTE Associate Pastor position** (*the FTE of the Associate Pastor position needs to be confirmed*).
- A coordinated worship schedule across the three congregations and the monthly Unity College Music Ministry service (to be reviewed after an agreed-upon timeframe)

It is further recommended that:

- All three congregations will issue joint calls for both pastor positions **as required**.
- All three congregations will request the College of Bishops to alter the assignment of Pastor Paul Calnan to include all three congregations and to increase the position from **0.5FTE to 0.6FTE** (*the FTE increase needs to be confirmed*).
- A joint call committee, with representatives from all three congregations, will be established to begin the call process for a suitable Lead Pastor.
- We agree in principle with the two pastor role descriptions as provided.
- The financial contributions required from the three congregations will be finalised by representatives from the congregations and will be endorsed at future properly constituted meetings of the congregations.

It is further recommended that:

- A task group, with representatives from all three congregations, be established to undertake a governance-administrative review of operations across all three congregations and provide recommendations for improvements.
