"LIFE THROUGH THE LENS"

As I was walking past the water outlet from the roof to the roadside gutter, I was stopped by something that had to be impossible.

Small pieces of foliage and old petals floating in mid-air appeared as if nothing was supporting them. They were suspended as if in mid-air, with the dull sunlight casting shadows beneath them.

On my knees and looking closer, I could still not see anything supporting these pieces of windblown litter. Changing my position and viewing angle, and as the sun shone out from behind a cloud, I finally saw it. There, glinting in the sunlight, were the merest hints of a mostly invisible spider web.

Life can be like that. Only when we pause, change our position, look more closely, let light shine in will we see more clearly and better understand what previously had only created questions.

We all have times in our lives when we feel like litter. Blown along the gutter of life, no one appears to care where I will finish up. Even my friends are more interested in themselves than the support I might feel I need. Or could it be I'm too concerned with "ME", and we have drifted apart, and the care I once relied on has drifted off to somewhere else, to someone else, without me realising what was happening? Or maybe the friend's care is still there, and I need to stop and look closely to recognise it, which wrapped in my self-interest I no longer see?

It is so easy to get so wrapped up in our own lives, our needs, our fears, our priorities that we forget God. We may even forget the times we have felt his supporting love. We forget He has promised, "'The mountains may shift, and the hills may be shaken, but my faithful love won't shift from you, and my covenant of peace won't be shaken,' says the Lord." (Isaiah 54:10)

Maybe it could be the time to stop, look more closely, and realise that even though you may not have seen or felt God's supportive love in your life, it has been there; continuously. Stop and ask him to help you recognise his love, and care, for you in the everyday minutes of life. He has also made this promise, "Be sure of this—that I am with you always, even to the end of the world." (Matthew 28:20) Talk to him about it if you feel you could do with his support and love.

May you feel His love in your life, day by day, Kevin.

Transfiguration Sunday

WHITE is used in all festivals of our Lord, this represents the purity, majesty and splendour of God.

Creative Response

This coming Wednesday (March 6th) is Ash Wednesday, the first day of Lent. The association of the day with ashes goes back to the 6th century. For centuries, Christians have received ashes on the head as a reminder of mortality and a sign of sorrow for sin.

To mark the beginning of Lent, set aside a period of time this week to "unplug" from technology and luxuries. Choose not to watch TV, or to use computers and other electronic devices for leisure purposes. Eat simple foods and drink only water. Have a time of silence in your household during which you reflect on the gifts of God and your relationship with him.

If you are unable to attend a worship service on Wednesday, have a brief time of observance in your home. Prepare in advance a small bowl of ashes to use.

Bible readings: Genesis 3:19 and Mark 1:15

Prayer: Heavenly Father, as we enter the season of Lent today, we confess our need for a Saviour. Prepare our hearts and minds throughout this season so that we may grow in serving others, showing thanks for how your Son has loved and served us. Amen.

Leader: Let us mark one another with ashes as a sign of sorrow for our sin, and our trust in Jesus to save us.

Household members take turns in making the sign of the cross with ashes on one another's foreheads, saying these words: "Dust you are, and to dust you shall return. Repent and look to Jesus your Saviour."

Service 🕶

The day before Ash wednesday is called Shrove Tuesday.

The name 'shrove' comes from the practice of being 'shriven' - going to church to confess your sins and receive absolution - before the start of Lent. Shrove Tuesday is also sometimes called Pancake Tuesday or Fat Tuesday, because households used up their remaining eggs and fats before Lent by making pancakes.
