This unbelievable gizmo made by a friend as a birthday present is based on the Fibonacci Spirals. What are the Fibonacci Spirals, you might ask. Well, prepare to be amazed. (While I had a basic understanding, I had to ask "Google" to help with the explanation)

A perfect example is the nautilus shell, whose chambers adhere to the Fibonacci sequence's logarithmic spiral almost perfectly. This famous pattern is everywhere in nature, including flowers, pinecones, hurricanes, and even colossal spiral galaxies in space.

To create the Fibonacci Sequence, take a calculator and begin by adding 1 + 1 to get 2. Then, add 1 + 2 to get 3. Then add 2 + 3 to get 5. Continue as long as your calculator can handle it — the numbers quickly get quite big. The sequence theoretically continues infinitely even after the numbers exceed the calculator's abilities.

Because of the pattern and the perfect meshing of the gear teeth created by the craftsman, as impossible as it may appear, these spirals can be spun in either a clockwise or counterclockwise direction.
