Luke 4:14-21

Last Sunday we looked at 1 Corinthians 12 which talked about the gifts of the Spirit. Gifts given that we might live life up close and personal with Jesus and with each other. Encouraging each other. Building each other up. Living this relationship together. Because that's Jesus' goal.

How do I know that this is Jesus' goal?
